Statement on the alleged release of results of some Chief Officer Interviews by Baringo County Public Service Board

Our attention has been drawn to another fake list of names circulating on social media, purported to be those of results of interviewed shortlisted candidates for some Chief Officer positions.

This is to categorically make it clear that no such list or results have been produced or released by Baringo County Public Service Board (BCPSB). The recruitment process for making recommendations to fill the Chief Officer Positions is still a work in progress and only the Board can make such a pronouncement through authentic and official media.

In this regard, therefore, we wish to inform members of the public and all our stakeholders that the latest alleged release of some results is also fake, maliciously authored by rogue individuals out to mislead the public for reasons best known to themselves, in contravention of the provisions of the Computer Misuse and Cybercrimes Act, 2018.

In this regard, the Baringo County residents and indeed all Kenyans are advised hereby to not only ignore it but also to provide any information they may have on suspected authors to the Police or the Board to help in bringing the perpetrators to book and in stopping the spread of such fake and s news and malicious information that may mislead members of the public, as provided for by the law.

The Board strictly observes the principle of equal opportunity in employment and conducts all recruitment processes with professional diligence. All results for vacancies as advertised are published as soon as they are ready, on duly signed press releases and published vide the Board's official online platforms.
